Oorsig oor die eerste drie weke van oes:

Almal is opgewonde oor die 2024 oes. Tans is baie produsente reeds aan die oes of maak gereed vir oes.

Die vraag op almal se lippe is hoe lyk die oes en die kwaliteit?

Die eerste 3 weke se oes data toon dat Wichita, Choctaw en Western Schley kultivars meestal ontvang was. Neute ontvang was grootliks Oversize – Large neute.

Kwaliteit tot op hede ontvang is goed en indien mens dit waag om te vergelyk, wil die vroeë seisoen kwaliteit voorkom of dit min of meer die selfde sal wees as 2023 se oes. Dus kwaliteit neute met meer tonne as 2023.

Ons wil graag die produsente bedank vir hul samewerking wat enkel kultivar begin oes het, dit maak 'n reuse bydrae tot kwaliteit van die neute ontvang.

Bykomend is daar 'n sterk fokus op kwaliteit deur al die verwerkers, tesame met belangrike beleggings in X-straal/AI-masjienerie en suksesvolle pogings om Suid-Afrika se kraak kapasiteit te verhoog. Die doel is om kwaliteit lewerings aan ons markte te verseker. Hierdie aksies sal help om Suid-Afrika te diffrensieer van die produk van VSA en Mexico.

Tans is vraag na produk laag uit China, die verwagting is dat die vraag oor die volgende maand of twee sal herstel.

Vir die verwerker: Aktiewe en oordeelkundige deelname van verwerkers is uiters belangrik om die mark stabiel te hou. Om nou te reageer op hoorsê is gevaarlik en kan die bedryf benadeel, maak seker van feite voor jy dit glo.

Dus in 'n neutedop kan ons opgewonde wees oor 'n goeie oes met kwaliteit neute wat vir ons wag.

Overview of the first three weeks of harvest:

We are excited about the 2024 harvest. Currently, many producers are already in the midst of harvesting or preparing for it.

The burning question on everyone's mind is: What does the harvest look like and what about the quality?

Data from the first three weeks of harvest show that Wichita, Choctaw, and Western Schley cultivars have been predominantly received. The received nuts have been largely Oversize – Large nuts.

The quality received thus far has been good, and if one dares to compare, early season quality appears to match the 2023 harvest. Hence, quality nuts with more tons compared to 2023.

We would like to thank the producers for their cooperation regarding single cultivar harvest; it contributes significantly to the quality of the received nuts. Additionally, there is a strong emphasis on quality by all processors, coupled with significant investments in X-ray/AI machinery and successful efforts to increase our shelling capacity. The goal is to ensure quality to our markets. These actions will help differentiate South Africa from the products of the USA and Mexico.

Currently, the demand from China is low; however, expectations are that demand will recover over the next month or two.

For the processor: Active and prudent participation from processors is crucial to maintaining market stability. Reacting to hearsay now is risky and could harm the industry; make sure of the facts before believing it.

In a nutshell, we can be excited about a good harvest with quality nuts awaiting us.
