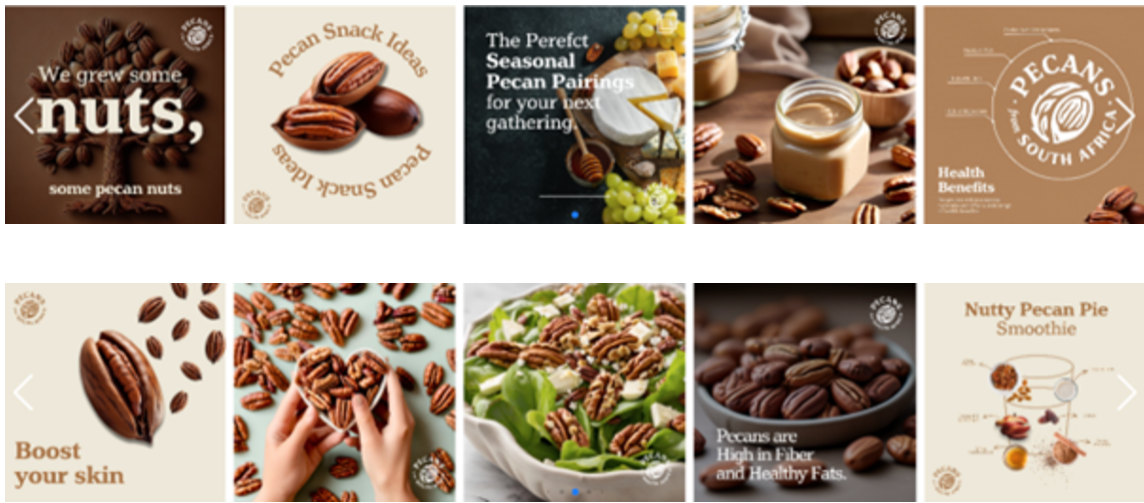
Thanks to technology we can share our pecans with the world via Social media.
