BIOLOGICAL ACTIVE INGREDIENTS



Biological active ingredients **do not have long environmental half-lives.**



BUT PACKAGING DOES



Packaging and any other waste associated with spent product **do not naturally degrade.**



KEY MESSAGE



Although biological active ingredients often degrade naturally,

IT IS THE PRODUCER'S LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY

to ensure packaging and any other waste associated with spent product is covered by an approved EPR scheme.

LEGAL FRAMEWORK



ACT 36 OF 1947

Regulates product registration, packaging & labelling.



ERP REGULATIONS (WASTE ACT)

Regulates end-of-life responsibility for packaging and associated waste.
